accorded and moreover, it has come to our knowledge that no such assurance or even indication therefor was given by India Govt.

We all are aware that taking NAP (2 groups) Communist Party and Congress along with Awami League a joint <sup>front</sup> ~~front~~ in fact has been formed naming a consultative committee for the liberation struggle against the avowed policy of our leader Sk. Mujibar Rahman. On such vital matter even no opinion was taken from Awami League and the repurcussion of the same in and outside the country is easily <sup>discernible</sup> ~~discernible~~. Reports were made to be published in newspapers to justify that 23 countries would accord recognition. No recognition has yet come from any quarter. It is also heard that a planning cell in the context of the present liberation struggle has been formed by the Prime Minister consisting of some persons. None of them is Awami Leaguer nor do they believe in the ideology of Awami League.

In the light of all these happenings the members adopted unanimous resolutions which are given in annexure "B". In the said adjourned meeting the Sub-Committee was once again requested to make another attempt to meet the Prime Minister and know the steps he was going to take in the light of the memorandum and resolution already submitted to him. The members also unanimously authorized the sub-Committee to circulate the proceedings of both the meetings among all elected representative for their due consideration.



ANNEXURE "B"

The adjourned meeting of the elected representative of the Zone Khulna Medical, Patuakhali and part of Faridpur District held on 12th Sept., 1971 unanimously adopted the following resolution, Mr. Foyat Hossain Khan, M.N.A. being in the chair.

1. The meetings noted with deep regret the evasive attitude of the Prime Minister for allowing deputations an interview.
2. In consideration of so many serious allegation against Prime Minister the House is of opinion that the he as the Prime Minister and as Secretary of Awami League has failed to discharge his duties faithfully and as such immediate steps be taken to prevail on the Awami High Command to make him resign from his position of both Awami League and Cabinet membership.
3. Resolved that another sub-committee be formed to make arrangement for circulation of the memorandum and resolutions among all the elected representatives of different zones for ventilation of their opinion, seeking their ~~active~~ active and sincere cooperation in this behalf.
4. Resolved that the said subcommittee be authorised to make liaison with the members of other zones and to collect the resolutions they adopted on 5/9/71 in connection with the formation the alleged Zonal Council.
5. This meeting also reiterates its previous stand for joint session of the M.N.A.'s and M.P.A.'s as embodied in resolution No. (4) of Annexure "A".
